

## **GLASGOW EAST END PATH NETWORK AND GREENSPACE STUDY**

### **Kelvin Clyde Greenspace**



TP&E was commissioned as a subconsultant to the City Design Co-operative to develop links between green spaces and a Core Path Plan in East Glasgow. TP&E assisted in the development of GIS maps showing desire lines of 550 walking and cycling routes throughout the east end of Glasgow. The maps indicate where people want to go by foot and bike, where they don't want to go, and why they don't feel comfortable going there. Glasgow City Council will use the information to develop the area and further their Core Path Plan. The project will be completed in December of 2006.
